Recruiting Parents


- To host a team in their home

Game Plan

- PRAY

- Find 4 or 5 other parents who will commit to help cook and/or serve each week of the season
- Secure the person to lead the devotions

Game Day

- Arrive early and have a meal ready when team arrives. Each person having an assigned job makes it run smoothly.
- Make sure each player is greeted by name, with a smile and feels very welcome.
- Get to know players and coaches as they come through the line and eat.
- Allow 10 to 15 minutes for devotion and make sure they have plenty of time to get to school.
- Make sure to send them off with a hug or word of encouragement !
