Cost of Mission:

1. \$1000
2. If your monies is over \$1000 – the monies you paid for your airline ticket will be reimbursed for your airline ticket; also you can purchase your airline tickets thru FCA Missions
3. Total Cost - \$1000 - Plus Cost of your Plane Ticket
4. The above cost will cover & includes the Mission, Transportation, All Meals; bags may or may not be included in the cost & your 2nd bag will contain FCA Equipment for the week of mission... You will need a passport ~ so do that NOW please!
5. FCA Missions depart Saturday & we will arrive back in USA/Atlanta –
6. End of the Trip will include beach day or R&R Day to Reflect/Enjoy/Chill...

Deposit Dates & All Deposits are NON-Refundable...

1. Deposits due:
December/January/February –
\$ 300.00 per month & [*\$100 – November*]
First of Each Month
2. Deposit or Purchasing of Your Airline Ticket should be no later than two months out... Let's talk about purchasing your airline ticket & save – Joey Potter/FCA Missions 239-292-4178...
3. Purchase of Passport should be September and your shots & Vaccinations should be in November at the latest – #3 is something you can take care of and information is below...

How to Raise FCA Missions 2012 Funding:

60 letters to Friends & Family & Churches asking for financial support; at the bottom of each page [*a personal note paragraph to that person in the letter or family*]
(*Mail Letters Sept & Ask for Donation by November 1st*)...

60 emails acknowledging you are praying about them support you that week you send the letter/exactly 3 days after they receive the letters

60 Voice Mail Messages – reminding them of the letter they received and you will be talking with them...

60 Follow Up Phone Calls or Face to Face Meetings sharing about YOUR FCA Missions to Bahamas & Your Mission Work March 2012...

60 people or Churches praying for you regularly during the FCA Mission; and you set up a FCA MISSION BAHAMAS BLOG or Facebook...

Total Cost of your investment is: Four Hours Letters / \$7.00 in Envelopes / \$7.00 in copies of letters / \$14.00 in Stamps – and a lot of prayers...

Shots

I am attaching the packing list that we provide to teams so that you'll have a general framework of what is needed. Listed below are the immunizations and medications you'll need. I've marked them either as Required or as Suggested, as the case may be. I've also noted where you can get these shots at the least expense.

1. **Tetanus - Required**

Available from your family physician or even some doc in the boxes - try to get all these shots at one time for the least expensive option, if you have insurance that requires only a co-pay.

2. **Flu shot - Suggested**

Available almost anywhere

There are bunks & you have your private room; and there are individual private showers – but many times COLD SHOWERS!

So you NEED NO BEDDING or blankets!!! They have everything there for you to sleep...

For travel to and from:

- Passport/Airline Tickets (include 4 copies)-one to keep in your carry on, one for your team leader, one for your Travel Team Leader and one for the FCA Project Missions Coordinator)
- **A passport holder** that goes around your neck and under your cloths - not in a waist pack.
- 2 Suitcases (Max 50 lbs. each): 1 for Personal Items, 1 for Team supplies and materials
- 2 Carry On Bags** – 1 carryon bag and 1 additional personal article (purse, backpack or small camera or computer bag) Note: Must Meet Airline Size (Check websites) They are very strict about the size of these bags and the personal bag

must fit under the seat in front of you or the overhead if seated on a bulkhead seat. **** Carry enough clothes and toiletries in your carryon bag for 3 days**

- **Personal medications** including Malaria pills and over-the-counter medication for headache, joint aches, anti-diarrhea (Imodium or Pepto-Bismol) and stomach ache medication in your carryon. Band-Aids and antibiotic ointment (place in your bags with liquids and gels) **All liquids or gels must be less than 3 ounces each and fit in one quart-sized Ziploc bag.**
- **Yellow Immunization Card** or other approved immunization record (include **4 copies**-one to keep in your carry on, one for your team leader, one for your Travel Team Leader and one for the FCA Project Missions Coordinator)
- **Spending Money for Travel, Meals and Souvenirs**

Clothing: The area we will be in has conservative dress codes.

Men's and women's shirts should have sleeves and pants should not be tight, skirts or shorts should be close to knee length or longer.

Sports Shorts are FINE! – FYI; don't worry about the knee thing but just don't want butts showing – gals or guys!!!

- **Casual Clothes:** __ days (Athletic gear that you would wear to Coach or practice in... (Varies by length of trip)
- **Comfortable Travel Clothes:** 2 days – I wear sports shorts & sports shirt that is very comfortable for travel on planes...
- Walking Shoes, , Extra athletic shoes (in case your main pair gets wet)
- **Light weight Jacket** and/or **Rain Poncho** & **Hats for sun protection** when out walking

Toiletries:

- **Personal Medication:** Suggestion - Ginger Pills for upset stomach **All Medicines must be in original bottles and correctly labeled. Otherwise they might be thrown away by the airport inspectors.**
- **Insect repellent** with a high concentration of DEET (25% or higher), **Sunscreen** and **Chapstick**
- **Shampoo, Shower shoes** and **Soap** (Bar or Soft Soap) Hair dryers must be dual voltage (110-120 and 220-240 volts) One or two per team is sufficient.

- **2-3 LARGE Bath Towels** and Wash Cloths
- **Toothbrush and Toothpaste**
- **Hand Sanitizer, Wet Wipes** (no sinks at the school building)
- Ziploc Baggies, Quart Size and **Plastic Trash Bags for Dirty Laundry**
- **2 Rolls of toilet tissue**

Miscellaneous Needed Items

- **Flashlight with extra batteries is a must!**
- Camera, Film or spare memory cards and Batteries
- **Bible, Journal, and Pen for Devotion preparation**
- **Between Meal Snacks**, if desired for self and to share with your hosts and other team members (**nuts, crackers, candy and peanut butter** are good choices - *peanut butter must be packed in checked luggage – it's a gel to security inspectors*)
- **Small Pillow**
